What is Pressure Washing?

Pressure washing, or power washing, is the use of a high-pressure water spray wand (3000-8000 psi) to remove loose paint, mold, grime, dust, mud, chewing gum and dirt from surfaces and objects such as brick buildings, and concrete surfaces.

What is included in pressure washing a driveway?

- Prepare driveway and surrounding area. Clean up any dirt and debris on the concrete with a large push broom and shovel.
- Cover vegetation from overspray.
- Pre-treat oil and grease spots.
- Prepare pressure washer with correct solvents and pressure levels.
- Clean perimeter concrete, with high pressure wand.
- Remove large residue with high pressure wand.
- Surface clean large area with rotatory floor scrubber.
- Rinse concrete and recheck for remaining residue.

Extra Charges:

- Removal of black streaks.
- Removal of rust spots.
- Removal of oil spots.
